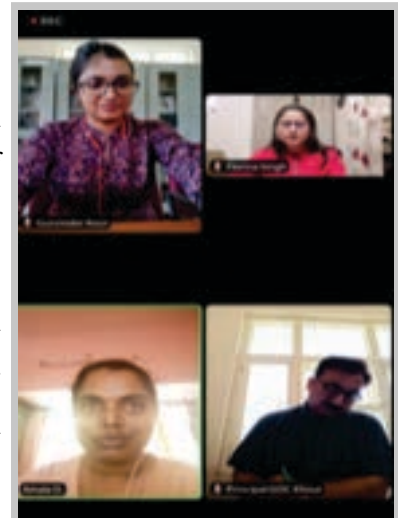

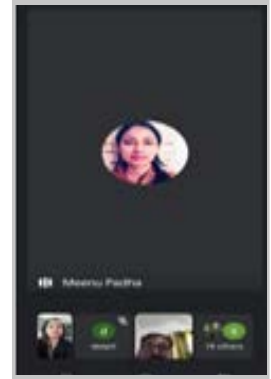
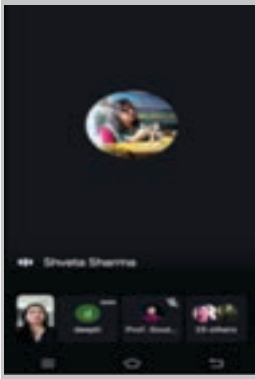






## Government Degree College, Khour (J&K)

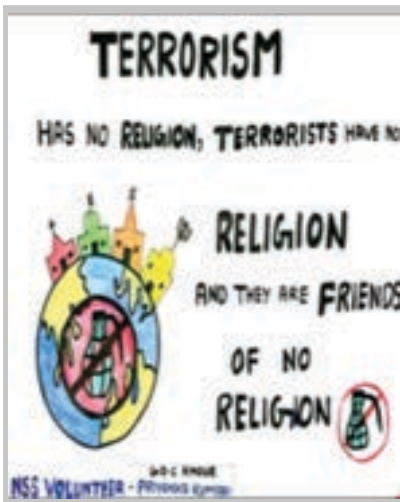
